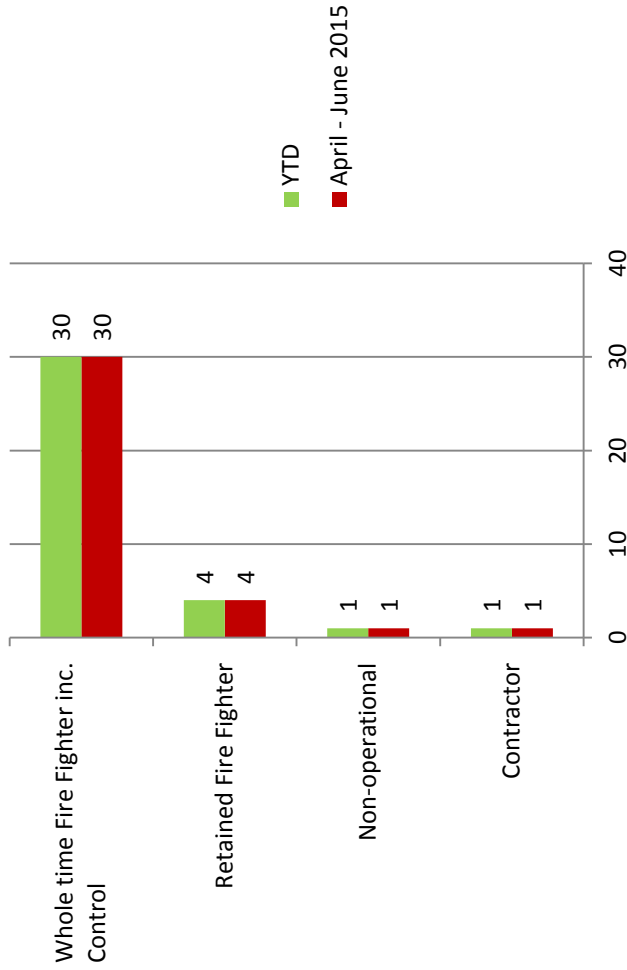


# 1st Quarter (April – June 2015) HS&E Performance Snapshot



**Role**

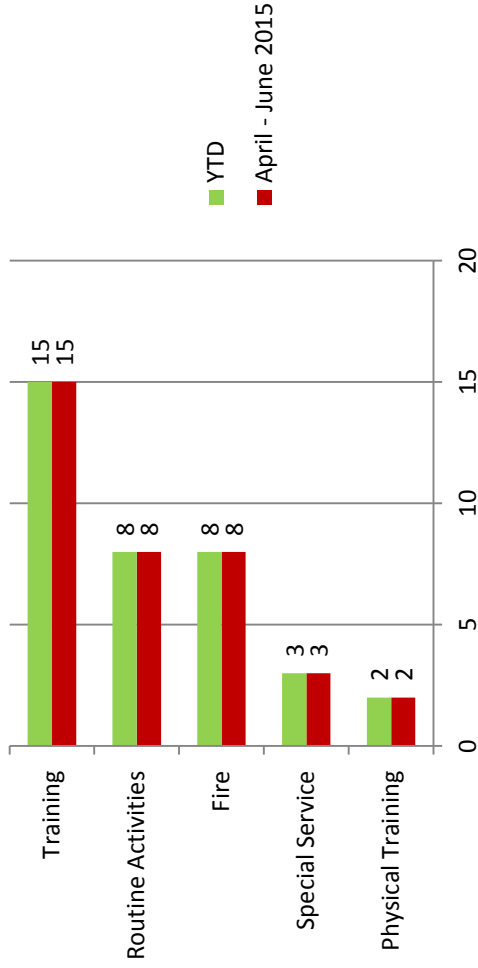


The graph above shows *role specific* incidents for this period (April – June 2015) alongside a running total for the year.

The data shows that Whole Time Fire Fighters are recording more incidents than Retained Fire Fighters and Non-operational personnel.

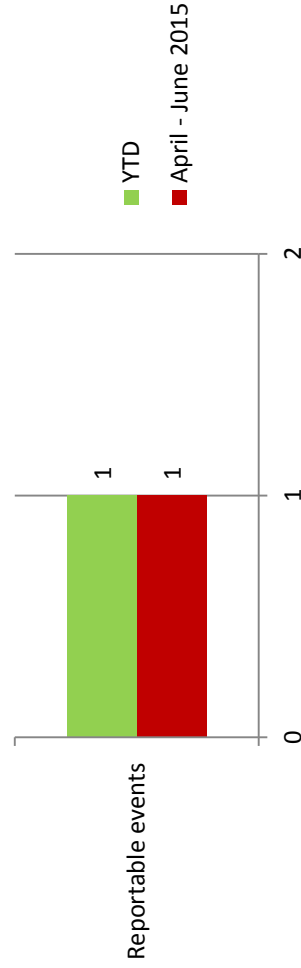
This could be due partly to the nature of their role and the environments to which they are exposed and the fact that this group accounts for 49% of all personnel of the Service.

**RIDDOR**

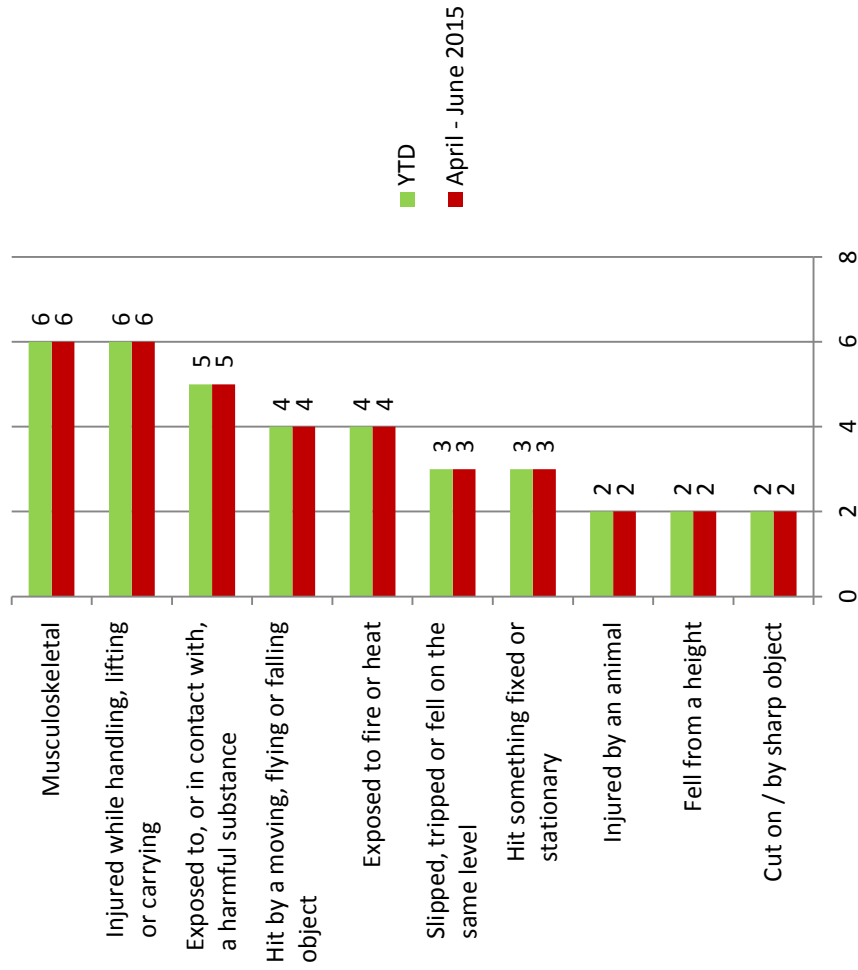


The incident that was reportable for this quarter was due to a breathing apparatus malfunction during a training exercise, the Service is working with the manufacturer to resolve the issue.

# 1st Quarter (April – June 2015) HS&E Performance Snap-shot



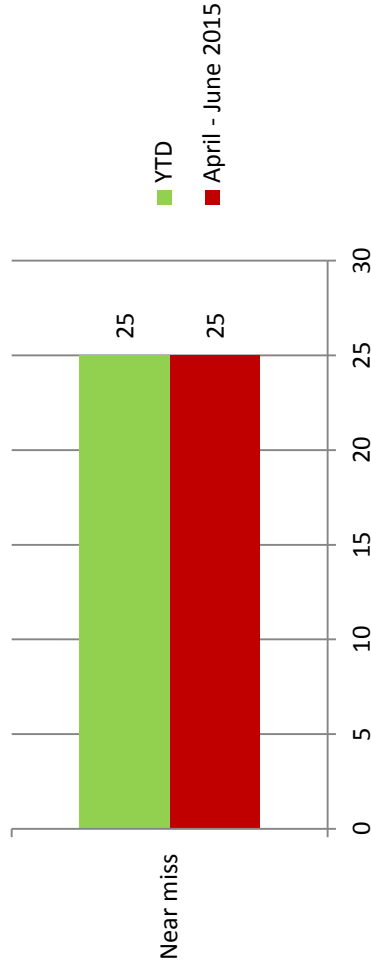
**Cause**



The graph shows the poorest performing factors for this quarter alongside the Year to Date figure.

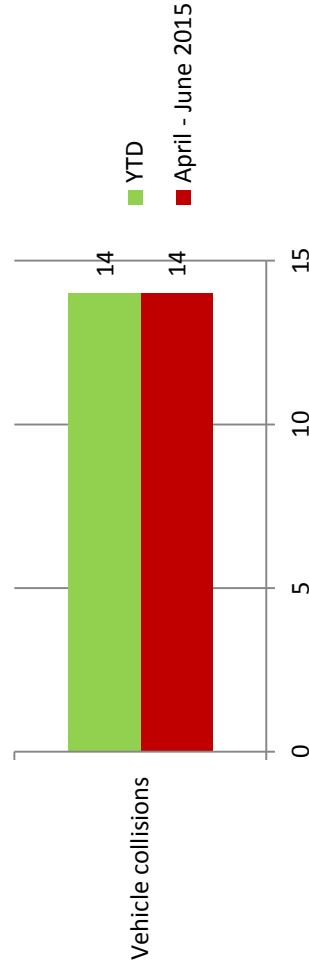
A review of manual handling training will be undertaken to address the issue of injuries whilst handling, lifting or carrying.
