

## HEALTH, SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL QUARTERLY REPORT 1<sup>st</sup> QUARTER 2015/16

April – June 2015

### SUMMARY

1. This is the 1st Quarter 2015/16 report on Health, Safety and Environmental. Appendix 1 provides a summary of statistical data. Supplementary information is available alongside the agenda papers for the meeting on the Authority's website [www.humbersidefire.gov.uk](http://www.humbersidefire.gov.uk).
2. During this period there have been 36 incidents that have been reported resulting in an injury; this is a slight increase of 5 compared to the same period last year.
3. One of the main contributing activities was during training which saw 15 incidents being reported, the health and safety team are liaising with the training section to mitigate future occurrences.
4. Only one RIDDOR event has occurred during this period compared to 6 for the same period last year, this was due to a breathing apparatus set malfunction during a training exercise. The Service is currently working with the set manufacturer to determine the most likely cause.
5. During this quarter the Service has gained an Industry Sector Silver Award from the Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents.
